Information about Hoopeston now appears on the Internet, thanks to resident Ron Lacy.

Lacy got the idea when he read about a Homer woman putting information on that community on the Internet.

A brochure put out by the city about 10 or 12 years ago was transferred to the information network, Lacy said. The brochure contains historical information about Hoopeston, as well as tidbits about local industries.

The information is on the Internet's home page, Lacy said. The home page "is the first page you see when you access the Internet from a commercial source," he said. "A lot of businesspeople just browse home pages around the world."

It took about two months to get the page on the system, Lacy said, adding he had help from an




