Hoopeston now spot on Information Highway

Hoopeston is now a spot on the Information Highway.

Information about Hoopeston now appears on the Internet, thanks to resident Ron Lacy.

Lacy got the idea when he read about a Homer woman putting information on that community on the Internet.

A brochure put out by the city about 10 or 12 years ago was transferred to the information network, Lacy said. The brochure contains historical information about Hoopeston, as well as tidbits about local industries.

The information is on the Internet's home page, Lacy said. The home page "is the first page you see when you access the Internet from a commercial source," he said. "A lot of businesspeople just browse home pages around the world."

It took about two months to get the page on the system, Lacy said, adding he had help from an

Internet-listed business, Dave's World. The owner of that business "told me he's gotten quite a bit of comment on (the Hoopeston brochure)," Lacy said.

Lacy plans to update the page when the new Chamber of Commerce brochure is available. He hopes the information will attract new business to Hoopeston.

"They claim 10,000 people a month access the Internet," he said. "I'm hoping somebody wanting to relocate their business just might see it. I'd like to think it would attract somebody."

Lacy will know if someone views the page, because the system is designed to send him the name and address of anyone who accesses the information.

The high-tech marketing venture has not gone unnoticed by city officials. "I appreciate what
