Teacher to trade textbooks for computer manuals

A long-time Hoopeston educator will trade in teaching students for working with computers.

The Hoopeston Area school board Thursday night approved transferring Larry Jahn from teacher to computer maintenance person.

High school principal Mark Conolly suggested the change, saying Jahn spends three periods daily trying to maintain the district's computer equipment and four periods teaching.

By switching the 30-year teacher to computer maintenance, the school will be able to offer additional computer applications courses to students.

Also, Conolly said, Jahn's undisclosed salary as a computer technician will be taken from the Charlotte Russell trust.

The trust, established in the late 1980s, is used, in part, to fund gifted programs at the high school.

The district receives approximately \$65,000 annually from the trust, Conolly said.

Not only will the district save money by having Jahn's salary paid from the trust, but it will also save by paying less than the going rate for computer repairs and save even more by hiring a new teacher in Jahn's position.

In related business, the board learned the district spent \$51,000 on 56 computers, which will be used to establish computer labs at John Greer and Honeywell grade schools.

Also, the district will purchase an additional eight to 10 machines for Maple Grade School, including one to be purchased and donated by the Community Bank.
