In what was called a "coming together celebration," the Hoopeston Multi Agency Service Center received the keys to the Eastern Illinois Multi Purpose Center.

EIMPC director Dorothy Metz presented the keys to Helen Kaufmann, Multi Agency board president, at a luncheon Monday.
