Hoopeston pool to host conference swim meet Saturday

Hoopeston will put its best, wet foot forward Saturday when the Hoopeston Swim Team hosts the 1995 Central Conference Swim Meet.

Approximately 300 swimmers from Milford, Gibson City, Vermilion Hills Country Club, Urbana Country Club, Paxton, Monticello and Rantoul will vie against Hoopeston swimmers, said Linda Haggerty, coach of the Hoopeston team.

The teams are those which Hoopeston swimmers compete against in dual meets during the swim season.

Participants in the invitational contest range in

age from 6 to 18 and will compete in five events:

freestyle, breast stroke, butterfly, back stroke and four-person freestyle relay, Haggerty said.

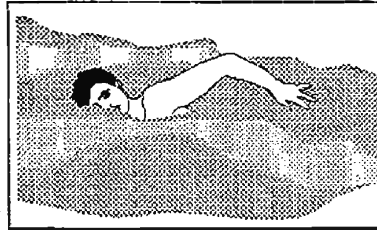
Competition begins at 9 a.m. Saturday. The top six swimmers in each category will move to finals competition in the afternoon.

"A lot of work's gone into this," Haggerty said, adding the Hoope-

ston team volunteered to host the meet.

The team has gotten help from Hoopeston Area schools and the Hoopeston Jaycees, which donated spectator bleachers which will be placed

Garman also sent Letterman postcards of Hoopeston and a Hoopeston care package, complete with Hoopeston Area Cornjerkers t-shirt, hat, key chain and coffee mug.


