Girl 'fine' following accident in rural Hoopeston Friday

A Hoopeston girl remains in Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, following an accident Friday night.

Megan Ervin, daughter of Dave and Charlene Ervin, was injured in a one-car accident at 10:49 p.m. Friday in a rural area southeast of Hoopeston.

"I'm doing fine," Ervin said Sunday afternoon,

adding that although she has a broken pelvis, she expects to be released from the hospital Wednesday.

Two other girls in the same car, Lisa Rudd and Aubrey Schellhardt, were treated at the scene.

Further details on the accident will not be available from the Vermilion County sheriff's department until Monday.

Hoopeston swimmers take fourth overall in conference

The Hoopeston swim team earned fourth place overall among eight teams in the 1995 Central Conference swim meet Saturday.

First place went to Vermilion Hills Country Club of Danville. "They have a lot of outstanding swimmers," said Hoopeston coach Linda Haggerty.

Second place went to Monticello, while Paxton took home third.

Rantoul garnered fifth place and Gibson City took sixth. Urbana Country Club and Milford rounded out the field with seventh and eighth place, respectively.

Twenty Hoopeston swimmers successfully completed the preliminary round to make to afternoon finals, Haggerty said.

Those swimmers competed in 37 positions.

Of those, two individuals received first place.

Trent Lockhart took first in the 9-10 year old boys' butterfly category while Charissa Snavelly took top honors in the 11-12 year old girls' back-

stroke.

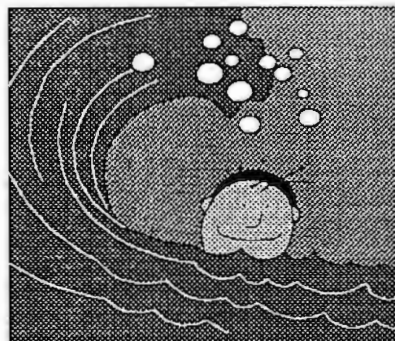
The Hoopeston team competing in the 9-10 year old boys' relay also got first. Relay members were Trent Lockhart, Brandon Snavelly, Nicholas Snavelly and Colby Thompson.

Other swimmers managed to get second and third place finishes. "That's what helped us finish in fourth place," Haggerty said.

Hoopeston played host for the meet for the first time, and Haggerty said people from other towns commented on how well the meet ran.

"This year, there were a lot of comments," Haggerty said. "People told me and other people that it was a perfect location and that things worked out wonderfully."

According to conference regulations, Hoopeston will host the meet again next year. "The first year is kind of a trial run so you figure out what went wrong and work on it for the second year," Haggerty said.
