

# Rossville village trustee resigns, suggests replacement

ROSSVILLE—The village board will be a member short following the resignation of trustee Sherry Ray.

Ray submitted her letter of resignation to Mayor Mery Smith on Aug. 7, citing conflicts with her work schedule. Her resignation was effective immediately.

Ray, who works at Blue Cross in Champaign, is often gone three or four days a week, and often reviews village business only on meeting nights and the Sunday preceeding meetings. "I just don't think that's enough time," she said.

Ray, who has been on the board approximately 2½ years, serves as finance committee chairman. a position which requires more time. "I think

youneed time to get in there and see what's going on," she said. "I feel like I'm rather ineffective at times."

Ray is suggesting Eva Neeland be named as her replacement.

Neeland recently retired from the Rossville Alvin school district, having served as bookkeeper for 26 years.

"I think somebody like Eva Neeland, who's retired but young enough...will have the time to devote to it and learn what's going on."

Whether Mayor Merv Smith will follow Ray's suggestion at the Aug. 21 meeting is unknown. Smith is on vacation and could not be reached for comment.
