The candidate who receives the highest vote total for each party in the march election will be on the November ballot as a candidate for election.

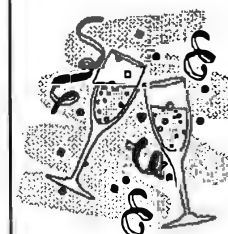
