Volunteers needed for United Way street corner drive

If you don't have anything to do Friday, how about standing on a street corner?

Volunteers are needed to man the intersection of Routes 1 and 9 Friday for the Grant Township United Way street corner collection.

Corner collectors are needed for two-hour shifts between 11 a.m. and 7 p.m., said Roberta Pennington, United Way fund drive chairman. "If we don't get out there and collect it, then we won't get it," she said.

The United Way drive began Oct. 1 and ends Oct. 31. A thermometer listing the amount pledged has been placed outside the Hoopeston municipal building. Pledges so far look "promising" towards the \$30,000 goal, Pennington said.

Nineteen agencies, serving everyone from children to senior citizens, receive money from the United Way, Pennington said.

Attorney urges buyer caution with used cars, warranties

Editor's Note: The following column, written by Hoopeston attorneys Calvin Hultquist and Kate Giffin, appear as space allows.

When a consumer buys a vehicle "as is," somehow buyers cannot believe that "no warranty" means no warranty.

Once in a blue moon, a crafty lawyer will find a way to beat a case where a dealer sold a car "as is" but it is an extremely difficult chore and rarely successful. So beware: all of the problems with the car become your

problems.

Many cars have warranties and new car warranties are usually very straightforward. Problems often arise, however, with used car warranties and extended warranties. *Do NOT purchase a warranty program or buy a used car with a warranty without first carefully examining the policy!*

Many used car warranties and extended warranties are so riddled with exceptions and

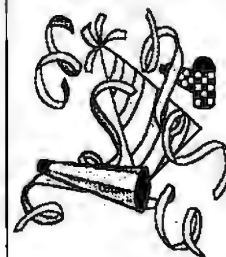

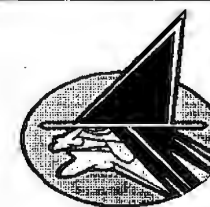

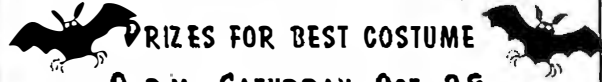

exclusions that very little is actually covered. Also, many used and new car warranties only cover drive train and only do so if you have religiously followed a maintenance schedule and can prove it.

First, know the car you are buying. The best bet is to have it checked by a mechanic before you buy. Second, read your actual warranty carefully. Do not rely on sales literature. If the dealer will not allow an inspection by a neutral mechanic or let you see the warranty policy, then buy somewhere else.
