


If the property is more appealing and is sold for business or industry - the corporation will have done its job, he said. "Historically, the corporation was set up in the 1950s to better the community of Hoopeston. The betterment of Hoopeston would be to bring in industry, to create jobs, expand the tax base."

Read said the decision to donate land was not based solely on monetary considerations.


