**Man's best friend can cause problems for unwary owners**

Let's face it, he is part of the family. He has his own place at the table, he sleeps on the bed, he rides in the car and vacations are almost always planned around whether a motel will take him or not. He is man's best friend, the family dog, a perfectly cuddly teddy bear. However, merely having a dog, or even a can, around does have its perils and liabilities.


Potentially the greatest source of liability for dog

owners is from dog bites. Although a dog is generally allowed "one free bite," there are exceptions to the rule. In order for a dog to be allowed one free bite and not exposed you to liability for injuries caused by the bite, the dog himself must be known to have a gentle, easy-going nature. If he has snapped at or bitten people, or even bitten another dog, the law treats you as being on notice that you own a potentially dangerous dog. If the dog bites a second time, you are strictly liable, regardless of whether you took steps to avoid the bit,



such as keeping the dog penned, chained or muzzled.

Certain dog breeds are excluded from the "one free bite" rule. German shepherds, rottweilers and pit bulls are dogs the law will consider inherently dangerous because of the breed's reputation as a "biter." If you own one of these dogs, you are liable on the first bite.

Even if your dog never bites a flea, you still may wind up in court defending his honor and your pocketbook. For example, if your dog has a habit of barking when he is lonely or if he romps in the yard without a leash, you may find yourself facing a \$75 fine or on trial if you plead him not guilty.

Further, all dogs and cats must be registered with the city each year. The fee for neutered dogs and non-neutered male dogs is \$2. The fee for a non-spayed female dog is \$10. Cat owners must pay a

\$10 registration fee for neutered and male cats. The fee for a non-spayed female cat is \$10.
