The accident occurred at about 6:15 p.m. Monday, when Mrs. Donnelly, backed up the family van to get to a garden tractor, said Vermilion County Coroner Lyle Irvin.

The Vermilion County Sheriff's Department was on Tuesday continuing its investigation of the accident, said chief investigator Gary Miller.
