Local man opens pizzeria at Parkview Lanes bowling alley

A Hoopeston man has opened a pizzeria/restaurant at Parkview Lanes.

Open Alley Restaurant and Pizzeria opened to bowlers on Oct. 1 and is now open to the public, said Dan Harper, who is leasing the restaurant from bowling alley owner Wayne Hickman.

The restaurant features "what we feel will be as good a pizza as you can get around here," Harper said. Also on the menu are cod and Italian beef sandwiches and appetizers such as onion blossoms, cheese fries, mozzarella sticks and giant soft pretzels.

The pizza recipe served at Open Alley came from a person in Indianapolis with more than 40 years in the pizza business. The recipe was chosen after a day-long pizza sampling by Harper and his wife, Shirley, who owns Henning's Root Beer Stand.

While Mrs. Harper has the majority of restaurant experience, Harper said he is no stranger to a kitchen. "I've always enjoyed cooking and I've helped out at the root beer stand," he said. But he admitted "Shirley's going to be my consultant in the background."

Diane Johnson has been hired to manage the restaurant. She is the former manager of a Paxton pizza establishment.

The restaurant is open from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday and 4-10 p.m. on Sunday and Monday.

Carry-outs and delivery service are available, including delivery to local factories during lunch hour, Harper said.
