



## HA school board approves purchase of special needs bus

The Hoopeston Area school board Thursday night approved purchasing a new bus for students with special needs.

The 1988 model will cost \$54,062 from Midwest Transit, the only company to submit a bid.

The 42-passenger bus will be equipped with a wheelchair lift and wheelchair locks, said transportation director Darrell Brown.

Brown said the district had considered trading in a 16-

passenger mini bus, but Midwest Transit would allow only a \$900 value for trade-in. "For \$900, we might as well hang on to that little mini bus," he said, adding the mini bus may be used to transport students to an alternative school in Danville.

The bus is expected to be delivered by June 30.

In other action, the board accepted the resignation of Kristin Lindgren, high school math teacher, effective Aug. 16.
