The group is seeking information leading to the arrest and conviction of two people who robbed the Hoopeston Shell Mart, Routes 1 and 9, on Sept. 16.

Two suspects were involved in the armed robbery, according to police. The first was a white male, 5'6" to 5'8", wearing a black hooded sweatshirt. This suspect showed a chrome or nickel revolver.

The second suspect is described as a Hispanic or lightskinned black male, 5'5" to 5"8". During the robbery this suspect work a stocking hat covering his face.
