## Local family's reunion no picnic with scheduling mix-up

A scheduling conflict at McFerren Park made a reunion no picnic for members of a local family.

The Linn/Hufford reunion was to be held Saturday in the Jaycee shelter at the park, but at Tuesday's city council meeting, family members said their reunion was run over by a car show sponsored by area car dealers.

Crown Ford had cars around the shelter, which had been reserved for the reunion since February, said reunion participant Sandy Cramer. The dealership offered to move some cars but not enough from the area where reunion-goers hoped to have a clear view of family children playing on nearby playground equipment.

The reunion was moved to the civic center, but Cramer said children were unable to play outside for fear of damaging vehicles.

solving the dilemma, which including setting up picnic tables in the civic center and cleaning up rain water in the building. "We are in no way unhappy with his performance," Cramer said.

The park should be used for citizens to enjoy recreation, not for businesses to increase profits, Cramer said, suggesting businesses rent the civic center or provide tents in other areas of the park.

Cramer said the disturbance cut down attendance at the reunion as well as the length the event lasted.
