

Hoopeston area welcomes motocross regional competitors

Motorcyclists throughout the Midwest will converge on Hoopeston this weekend.

The North Central Amateur Regional Motocross Championships will be held Saturday and Sunday at Bailey Motosports Park in rural Hoopeston, said Jim Bailey.

Bailey and his brother, Todd, own the park.

Between 300 and 500 riders from Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Florida, Georgia and Arkansas are expected. "It'll be a busy weekend," Bailey said.

Riders began arriving Wednesday and will continue through Friday night. They will fill area motels, and many will take advantage of free camping at the 23-acre motocross park, Bailey said.

It is not only the riders, but their families, as well, who

will be coming to Hoopeston. "It's really kind of neat they way they come around," Bailey said. "Motocross at the amateur level is really a family sport."

Saturday action begins with practice at 9 a.m. Races will begin at 11 a.m. and continue until 6 or 7 p.m. Sunday, practice will begin at 8 a.m. followed by racing at 9

Riders will compete in 17 classes based on bike size, riding experience and age. Motorcycles used in races will include 125, 250 and 500 cc.

Two motos will be run Saturday and a third Sunday. The combined total of the three will give the overall score in determining winners in each class.

Group halfway to 100 new members for library centennial

A local group is halfway to its goal of 100 new members to mark the centennial of the Hoopeston Public Li-

Friends of the Library in March began a campaign to add 100 members to the rolls by the November, when the library celebrates its 100th birthday, said group president Barbara Powley.

The group has 85 memberships divided among individual, family, student, business, clubs and lifetime categories.

Dues vary by category, including \$1 for students, \$3 for individuals, \$5 for families, \$25 for clubs and businesses and \$50 for lifetime memberships, Powley said.

Money raised through the membership drive will be used in two ways.

First, the group would like to "spruce the place up" by purchasing new window coverings for the main library and new furnishings for the children's room, Powley

Some funds will also be used for the library centennial celebration, tentatively scheduled for Nov. 27-28. Final plans for the event have not been finalized, but an open house is being considered, along with refreshments and gifts. The group would also like to include a handout for the centennial and National Book Week, she said.

But Friends of the Library is looking for more than just money from residents. They're also looking for time.

The group is "a source of people who like to volunteer," Powley said. Volunteers mend books and donate time in other areas, she said. Volunteers will also be asked to assist with the centennial celebration.

Besides dues, Friends of the Library raises money

out the country, Bailey said. Winners in each class will go to finals competition in August at Hurricane Mills, part of the Loretta Lynn circuit.

Although the park hosts area qualifiers yearly, this is the second time in the six-season history of the park that regional races have been run here.

In order for riders to compete, they must be members of the American Motorcyclist Association, Bailey said, adding no local people are competing.

Admission to the races is \$8 per day per person or \$15 for a two-day pass. Children under six will be admitted free.
