The kid in her enjoys taking part in activities scheduled for her young charges, including music awareness, computer basics, outdoor play and daily arts and crafts.

Burke-Hernandez' love of children goes beyond providing daycare for 16 years. She also works for DCFS, with parents whose children have been taken from the home, as well as supervising visits between parents and their children.

"My job is to go in and start from scratch and teach them how to have a life," she said. Burke-Hernandez teaches parents reading, writing, parenting skills, providing nutritious, economic meals and money management. When children visit their parents, Burke-Hernandez supervises to make sure parenting skills learned are being used.

Seeing the situations her DCFS clients are in gives Burke-Hernandez deeper appreciation for children. Dealing with children who carry scars from being beaten, who have needed reconstructive surgery from molestation, makes the little cuts, scrapes and complaints of other children less of a "frazzle factor."

In her spare time, Burke-Hernandez is a DCFS literacy teacher, teaches English to Spanish-speaking people, is a registered electrologist and has a weekend disk jockey service, Locamotion.

Even when Burke-Hernandez isn't doing anything, she's still busy. "I'm moving all the time," she said. "I never finish a movie. I just keep jumping up to do things."
