### Chamber of Commerce flying high with banners, billboard

A new breeze is blowing in Hoopeston and it's making for a more beautiful roadway.

The Hoopeston Chamber of Commerce, which earlier this year designed a new logo, is using the design to make Hoopeston more attractive.

The logo is being displayed on banners along Route 1, and soon down

Main and Market Sts. The Chamber's billboard on Route 1 north carries the same design.

Awards, with input from the Chamber board, said Chamber president Dave McFadden. The four-color graphic includes houses, a tractor and people in various activities, as well as the slogan "Keeping A Good Thing Growing."

The banner project was enthusiastically supported by the business community, McFadden said. "We didn't solicit anybody directly," he said, adding the Chamber mailed details of the program to members. "We sold out about two weeks before the deadline," he said.

Twenty-seven banners will grace the streets, including 14 on Route 1 from Route 9 to near Main St. Another 13 will be placed on Main and Market.

The banners, 60"x30",

will fly until Christmas decorations are put up this year. However, next year, the decorations will be put up in May and remain until sometime after the National Sweetcorn Festival. The banners are expected to last four to five seasons.

Placing banners on Route 1 was an important component to the program. "We knew if we couldn't do it on Route 1 as well as downtown, we weren't going to do it," McFadden said.

### Hoopeston woman wins honors at national convention

A Hoopeston basket designer was honored at a trade show last weekend.
