Voting aids available

Vermilion County residents who are unable to register to vote due to a disability may call the County Clerk's Voter registration Hotline at (217) 431-6688 for assistance. The office can arrange for bipartisan team of deputy registrars to provide in-home registration services. The last day for county residents to register for the April 13 election is Monday, March 15.

Also, people who are disabled or incapacitated and who wish to vote absentee by mail should request an application from the county clerk as soon as possible after March 4. The voter must mail the completed application or deliver it in person to have a ballot sent by mail. The last day an absentee ballot may be mailed to a voter is Thursday, April 8.

Voters who are permanently disabled may request an application for a special identification card which will allow them to receive absentee ballot applications for every election for five years. The card is renewable.
