Mike Bane. 47. has "several ideas on how to make Hoopeston a better place to live and would like the op-



Ward 1 voters will also have a choice to make, for a two-year term, between a relative newcomer and a challenger.

Rodney C. Kaag, 37, was appointed to the council to replace Mark Drollinger, who resigned to become police chief.

Kaag also sees several important issues in the city, including business growth, the proposed TIF district and the sports complex.

Kaag supports a TIF district, but said it must be thoroughly researched. He would like to promote business growth through long range planning to offer incentives ad by cooperating with the Chamber of Commerce and other groups.

As for the sports complex, Kaag said as alderman he is willing to assist the steering committee in any way possible.

Kaag graduated from Hoopeston-East Lynn High

School and attended Danville Area Community College. He has worked for the Vermilion County Sheriff's Department for 14 years and is currently assigned to the

criminal investigations division.

Challenger **Ron Longest** did not return his candidate questionnaire; neither did Ward 3 challenger Tom Garrison.

Incumbent Alderman **Harold Cox** hopes to keep his fourth ward seat. "I have the time to serve and my door will be open to the people of Ward 4," he said. "We need to clean up our environment and be efficient in all aspects of our city government."

Cox is president of the Hoopeston Industrial Corporation and has served as Vermilion County treasurer, and owned the Hoopeston Insurance Agency for 37 years.

He is being challenged by Don York who was profiled previously.
