### Ameren/CIPS customers won't have to sweat hot spell

Area customers of Ameren/CIPS don't have to sweat the summer hot spell underway.

The company will have plenty of electricity to meet the needs of its customers, said local manager Kim Smith.

"We haven't had any problems with outages or brownouts or anything like that and we don't anticipate any," he said.

The plentiful power supply is due to equipment upgrades. "We've spent a lot of money updating equipment to avoid that situation," he said.

Unlike utilities in other areas, Ameren/CIPS has not asked customers to observe energy-conserving measures. A small reserve of power means such notices will probably not be issued, Smith said.

Should the power supply dwindle, conservation notices would be issued to industrial customers first, followed by a general bulletin asking customers to set thermostats up one or two degrees, he said.

Additional energy-saving suggestions include using some household appliances, such as dishwashers, washing machines and dryers, during the early morning or evening. "It's kind of common sense for your house but it helps us out, too," Smith said.

Ameren/CIPS is part of a grid of electric companies that provide power to each other. Excess electricity produced by the company is being sent to other providers, such as Commonwealth Edison in Chicago, Illinois Power and Public Service of Indiana.

Sending power to those companies is not expected to affect customers in the Ameren/CIPS service area. "Our first obligation is to our own customers," Smith said.


### Patients moved when A/C dies
