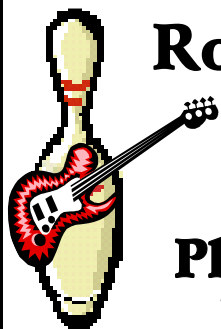

## Housing needed for record number of pageant contestants

There is good news and bad news for organizers of the National Sweetheart Pageant.

The good news is a record number of girls has signed up to take part in the pageant, part of the National Sweetcorn Festival.

The bad news is they don't have enough places to house them.

A record 32 girls are expected to participate in the pageant, said co-director Delores Crabtree. Twenty-eight appeared last year.

More states are sending representatives but no new states have been added. “They just all came together this

year,” Crabtree said.

One girl, Shanna Kari Moore of Kentucky, is making her second appearance at the Sweetheart Pageant.

The girls, who will arrive Aug. 30, stay with local families, some of whom keep more than one girl.

Families who provide housing are not responsible for taking contestants to appearances, and, in fact, do not see much of their houseguests. “They leave at 6:30 or 7 in the morning and don't get home until 8:30 p.m. or later,” Crabtree said.

The girls do not make much extra work for families,
