**Hubbard Trail Country Club to hold New Year's Eve drawing**

Y2K will be no problem for the lucky winner of \$70k. Hubbard Trail Country Club plans to give one lucky winner \$70,000 on New Year's Eve. Money for the drawing is being raised by selling 2,000 tickets at \$100 each. The drawing will be held at midnight. The second place winner will receive \$20,000 and a third place winner will receive \$10,000. But ticket-buyers aren't the only ones who will benefit, said club general manager George Fix. Hoopeston Area and Rossville-Alvin schools will also benefit. If all tickets are sold, each school will receive \$10,000 from the club's profits. Both the schools' winning and individual winners' shares will be awarded on a percentage basis if fewer than 2,000 tickets are sold. Each district has already made plans to spend the total windfall. 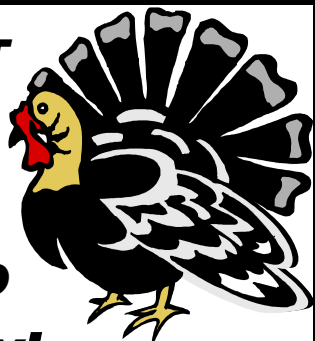

but new wiring would allow students to better access the internet.

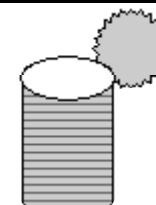
