

New minister roping musicians, souls in new church service

A new minister is hoping to rope some country musicians—and new souls, as well.

Bud McMasters, newly-named pastor at the Chestnut Street Church of Christ, is forming a Cowboy Church.

The music-based service will begin in about six weeks. McMasters has singers and an acoustic guitar, but still needs a steel or lead guitar player, fiddler and banjo player. "We could use a good keyboard player, too," he said.

The group will meet at 3 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 21 to

practice country and western, southern gospel, bluegrass and contemporary Christian music.

McMasters hopes to reach a segment of the population not being reached by traditional churches and curiosity-seekers interested in the cowboy services. Those who regularly attend other churches will be "encouraged to go back where they were at," he said. "We don't want other churches to worry about it."

The music will be different than that in most services,

Those who attend the festivities may end the day at the Christmas recital at the Academy for the Performing Arts.

as will the clothing. Coats and ties will be replaced with cowboy hats and flannel shirts. “I wear my boots and jeans to church,” McMasters said.

Those cowboy hats will come in handy at the service. The offering is collected in a hat, he said.

McMasters brought the idea for Cowboy Church from Farmer City, where attendance went “from nobody in church to 250 every Sunday.”

Cowboy Church services originated in 1990 in Nashville by Harry Yates and his wife, Joanne, sister of singer Johnny Cash.

This is not McMasters’ first time in Hoopeston. About 20 years ago, he was called to interview at the church, but turned the job down.

The new pastor hopes the new service will bring people together. “What’s good about it is nobody is arguing about their differences,” he said.
