**Planned purchase to expand Hoopeston Area playing fields**

Hoopeston Area officials have negotiated with the Hoopeston Industrial Corporation to expand the school's playing fields.

The sale was discussed at the Hoopeston Industrial Corporation's annual meeting Wednesday night.

The school plans to buy approximately five acres of HIC land at \$3,000 per acre, said Hoopeston Area Superintendent Mark Conolly.

The planned purchase will be bordered on the west by Hoopeston Area Middle School, on the south by the landfill road, on the east by the Grant Township gravel pile and on the north by existing football and baseball

fields, Conolly said.

The area will be developed as practice fields for soccer and other sports. "We've seen an explosion in youth soccer," Conolly said. "We've seen an explosion in other youth sports."

The land must still be surveyed to determine the exact size of the tract. Other details, such as landscaping and parking, must also be addressed.

It will be a few years before the land will actually be used by local athletes. "It's not just you buy it and boom, you play on it," Conolly said, adding it took approximately two years for the baseball field to be ready.

"The school district benefits and the community benefits," Conolly said. "We're excited about it."

After nearly 15 years in Hoopeston, the Resale Mart is moving to Paxton.

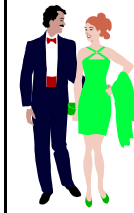
Friday will be the last day of business in Hoopeston, said owner Dorothy Allison.

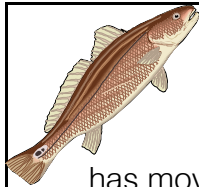

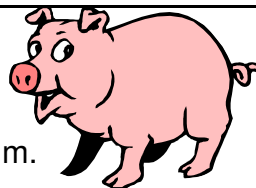
