## Good recipes to be fundraiser thank-you from Goodwine

A Hoopeston man has just the recipe for fundraising.

Bill Goodwine, part of the local effort to raise funds for a local YMCA, is offering one of three recipes to those who contribute to the program.

As a thank you for a \$5 contribution, Goodwine will send donors a recipe for baked spaghetti, a specialty of Maison de Bonvin (House of Good Wine). A \$10 contribution merits a recipe for jambalaya, while a \$20 donation guarantees the recipe for clam linguini. All three may be had for a \$35 donation.

While the first two are house favorites, Goodwine guarantees the linguini recipe. "It is **too** good," he said in a fundraising letter. "Even though there is no meat, it is **so** good, that it would be sinful for Catholics to serve it on Lenten Fridays."
