

Swap report shows Hoopeston's strengths, weaknesses

Hoopeston's good and bad points were the subject of a meeting Friday afternoon.

Six people from Clinton toured the city on June 5 as part of the University of Illinois Extension Service Community Swap program. The results of their visit were unveiled Friday.

A slide presentation showed Hoopeston's strengths, which included good signage for the library and snow routes; the community swimming pool; the intersection of Rtes. 1 and 9, including stores and eateries; local homes, including Parkview Court; and the Lorraine Theatre, called Hoopeston's "diamond." said Alderwoman Susan Comstock.

Comstock was one of six Hoopeston people who visited Clinton, ranking their community.

The biggest weakness cited by the visitors was negativity among downtown merchants, who could not answer questions about Hoopeston and what is available here, Comstock said. "One person said a merchant told him to go elsewhere because there was nothing here," she said.

Suggestions for improvement included better identification of the city's grade schools; cleaning debris and weeds from curbs and gutters in town; welcome signs at the south, east and west entrances to the city;

removing the city hall sign from the former municipal building and better marking of the new city hall; cleaning downtown parks and perhaps painting a mural on the wall next to Rotary Park; and a general cleaning and painting of the downtown, perhaps with the addition of awnings to businesses to make it look uniform, Comstock said.

The visitors commented that Hoopeston has may things in its favor. For example, the swap team said Hoopeston is fortunate to have a swimming pool. Clinton has tried unsuccessfully for years to get a pool constructed, Comstock said.

The swap, sponsored by the Hoopeston Chamber of Commerce, was an eye-opening experience. "If we learned anything, it is we need to reeducate the community on the positives Hoopeston has, not what it hasn't got," Comstock said. "They told us things we already knew but they were thing they needed somebody else to tell them."

unit. Telemedicine uses a computer connected to the Internet with real time audio and video communication, allowing doctors to consult with specialty physicians in other locations.

The equipment includes a stethoscope, X-ray viewing screen and magnifying camera.

One use of telemedicine has been specialty consultations for children with Attention Deficit Disorder. Parents can bring their children to the hospital to receive care they may otherwise not have gotten.

Physicians and staff also receive continuing education credit by means of telemedicine programming.
