



 As a retired State Police officer with more than 30 years' experience, I certainly know that good police work is wasted unless the State's Attorney's office is reasonably competent.
 Here in Vermilion County, we have terrible problems with the State's Attorney's office. Cases, even though involving serious crimes, are delayed for years, especially if private defense lawyers are involved. Many totally unreasonable plea bargains are made so that, for example, repeat drunk driving offenders can keep their licenses.

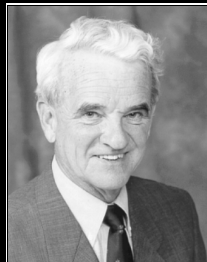
