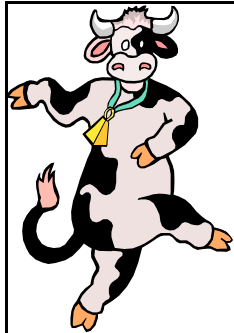

Girl Scout cookie sales begin Friday with new Aloha cookie

From Jan. 5-28, more than 4,000 girls in the Green Meadows Council will take orders for Girl Scout Cookies. Cookies will be delivered to customers beginning Feb. 28.

For the first time in nearly a decade, Girl Scout Cookie boxes will have a whole new look. Inside the new packages, consumers will find a brand new cookie called "Aloha Chips with Macadamia Nuts," a cookie containing white fudge chips and Macadamia nuts.

The new cookie joins seven traditional varieties: Thin Mints, Trefoils, Tagalong, Do-Si-Do, Samoa, Lemon Drop and Apple Cinnamon. Cookies are \$3 per box.

Cookie sales began soon after Juliet Gordon Low

founded Girl Scouts in 1912. Leaders and girls sold cookies to be self-reliant and fund troop activities. In the early days, girls baked shortbread cookies at home and held neighborhood bake sales. By 1934, several Girl Scout councils used commercial bakeries to assist in their efforts

During the 1940s, fewer cookies were sold during World War II due to limited amounts of flour, sugar and butter. By 1847, a total of 29 bakers were licensed to create cookies. The number was streamlined to four in 1980 and again streamlined to two.

DANVILLE—Lakeview College of Nursing was recently granted funds from the Vermilion Healthcare Foundation to offer mammography screening to any qualifying woman in the area.
 The screening will be available to women who meet the following criteria:

- 35 years or older.
- no insurance or Medicare
- no mammogram in the last 12 months.
- no breast biopsy

- no symptoms of breast disease (i.e. palpable lump or discharge from nipple)
- not pregnant or breast feeding.

The college will provide pre-screening for the program. Mammograms will be conducted by United Radiology Services at Provena United Samaritans Medical Center.
