HA board changes citizen participation policy at meetings

A request from a candidate running for office has prompted a change in Hoopeston Area's citizen participation policy for meetings.

The school board on Thursday unanimously approved the policy change. The existing policy mandated five days' notice for a resident to be put on the agenda; allowed a citizen to speak if he requested it before the meeting; and allowed the board to limit the number of citizens and the amount of time each might speak.

The change allows the board president to deny a person the right to speak if the topic is deemed inappropriate and allows the president to determine procedural

matters on participation not defined in the board policy.

Board president Larry Lobb said "I'm not trying to censor anybody." Board meetings are "not a forum for everybody to come and rant and rave about whatever." The change will not affect those who regularly attend meetings and wish to learn more about board issues.

District resident Mark Wagoner took exception to the change. "We pay the wages of the school district and I think we should have a say," he said.

Lobb responded that the board did not follow the previous policy to the letter and expected to do the same with the new one.

"If you're not going to follow it, why have it," Wagoner asked. "I just disagree with it."

In unrelated action, the board canvassed Tuesday's election in which four board members ran unopposed. Those members and their vote totals were:Lobb, 1,477, Duane Sheppard, 1,517, John Smiley 1,334, and Jeff Stipp 1,415.

The board also increased bus and room rental fees. Bus fees will be \$2 per mile plus \$20 per hour for a driver and \$80 for school rental and \$140 for the middle school gym, high school auditorium and kitchen/cafeteria.
