Planes to have dogfight over Hoopeston for movie premiere

A dogfight over Hoopeston will mark the premiere of the new movie "Pearl Harbor."

A World War II Japanese Zero and a P-40 will fly over the theater at 7 p.m. Friday.

The planes will be flown by Tom Frasca and Rudy Frasca, respectively. Rudy Frasca flew a replica of the Zero in "Tora, Tora, Tora," a 1970 movie and the P-40 appeared in the film "Midway" from 1976.

Other vintage memorabilia will be demonstrated and on display, including a World War II-era air raid siren, scheduled to be sounded at 7 p.m.; a searchlight, 5-ton Army trucks and possibly a Jeep.

Theater owner Greg Boardman and others will also be

dressed in period uniforms.

The sounds outside will match those inside while the movie is playing. "Pearl Harbor" will be shown in exclusive eight-channel digital sound, Boardman said.

"Pearl Harbor" stars Ben Affleck, Josh Hartnett, Cuba Gooding Jr. and Kate Beckinsale in a story of a love triangle during the time of the bombing of Pearl Harbor.

Friday's show times will be at 3:30 p.m., 7:30 p.m. and 11 p.m. After Friday, the movie will be shown at 4 and 7:30 p.m. daily; 12:30, 4, 7:30 and 11 p.m. Saturdays and 12:30, 4 and 7:30 Sundays.

Tickets are \$4.50 for matinees and for children 12 and under and \$6 for evening showings.

Hoopeston woman.

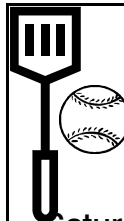
