Milford 'Rockin' Into the Millennium' during Fun Days

MILFORD—Residents hope the area will be "Rockin' Into the Millennium" during Milford Fun Days, June 14-17.

The event, with the motto "Better to Rock Out than Rust Out," will feature food and fun for all ages. A softball tournament, baby contest, dances, parade, petting zoo and other attractions will be combined with fish fries, BBQ and other delicacies throughout the weekend.

Activities begin at 5 p.m. Thursday when the beer tent opens. The tent will open at 5 p.m. Friday and noon Saturday and Sunday. A euchre tournament, karaoke and dances are among activities scheduled for the beer tent each day.

A crafts and antique show will begin at 5 p.m. Friday, along with the Lions Club fish fry and a farm equipment show. A Velcro wall, obstacle course and giant slide will

entertain children beginning at 6 p.m., located near the Milford Park tennis court.

Little Miss and Mr. Fun Days, a talent show and teen dance round out Friday's entertainment.

Saturday's events begin at 8 a.m. with Bessie Bingo, sponsored by the Future Farmers of American. Wright Travel will sponsor a walk-a-thon at 8 a.m. and a volleyball tournament will begin behind the band shell.

At 8:30 a.m., entrants will begin lining up in the city hall parking lot for the parade at 10:30. WHPO will announce the parade live.

At 11 a.m., the Milford Fire Department will hold its annual Pork Chop dinner at the park pavilion and a petting zoo and pony rides will be available in the park. The Milford Women's Club bake sale will also begin, as will

Red Cross to offer professional babysitter course locally

You're young and you want to spend the summer babysitting but you've never done it before and you're not sure what you need to know.

The Danville chapter of the American Red Cross has a solution.

An American Red Cross Babysitter Training course will be offered from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. Monday and Tuesday, July 23 and 24 at Hoopeston City Hall. Cost of the class is \$25 per participant.

The course includes a handbook, briefcase-sized tote bag, flash light, batteries, first aid supply pack, information notebook, course completion card, glow in the dark key chain/electric outlet covers and activity sheets for coloring, games and puzzles.

Course participants will learn babysitting fundamentals, such as interviewing for the job, what to

expect from the child's parents, handling an emergency or illness, accident prevention, how to play with children of all ages, choosing safe toys and games, dressing and diapering infants, feeding babies and preparing simple foods for children and emergency measures such as performing first aid and rescue breathing.

The course is open to young people ages 11-13. Participants must attend both days of the course for completion.

To register, youngsters may send their name, address, and phone number, along with a check for the registration fee to American Red Cross, 320 N. Franklin St., Danville, IL 61832.

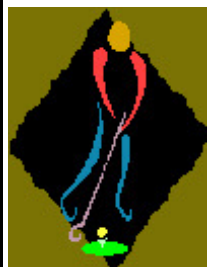
