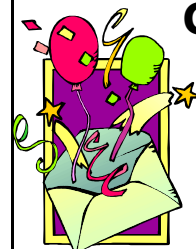

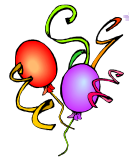

Eagle Wings plant still on hold pending corporate approval

A planned expansion of Eagle Wings Industries to
Hoopeston is still on hold pending corporate ap-
proval from both sides.

Eagle Wings, with a plant in Rantoul, and Chi-
quita, owner of the former Stokely plant, have agreed on
a purchase price but have not inked a final deal,
said Greg Regnier of the Rantoul facility.

Former Mayor Bob Ault announced in April that
Eagle Wings would locate in Hoopeston.

When the deal is finalized, the local plant is ex-
pected to hire 40 to 50 people
