# Woman achieves career goal, follows in family footsteps

An area woman is achieving a career goal and following in family footsteps at the same time.

Carol Rabe, a clerk at the Hoopeston Post Office, has been named postmaster at Danforth.

Rabe will begin in Danforth Nov. 13. Her last day in the Hoopeston office will be Nov. 9.

For the past seven years, Rabe has served as clerk at the local post office. "This is my one and only postal job," she said, crediting family influence with trying for the position.

Rabe's mother, Connie Courtney, had served as postmaster of Stockland, and then Wellington until her death. "She's the one who got me interested in applying for this job," Rabe said.

Once hired at the post office, it didn't take long for Rabe to realize

she wanted to make it a career. "Within the first couple years, I decided being a postmaster was my goal," she said.

During her tenure at Hoopeston, Rabe has served not only as clerk but also officer-in-charge, filling in for postmaster Paul Ziemnisky. "You don't have to do it but your chances are better of being a postmaster if you've been officer in charge," she said.

Rabe, and her husband, Randy, who is from Danforth, will be moving to the Danforth area. As postmaster there, Rabe will be responsible for all aspects of postal work. "I'll be doing the cleaning, I'll be selling stamps, I'll be doing everything," she said.

She will also be responsible for the office's financial records and paying bills.

Rabe has mixed feelings about leaving Hoopeston. I really do enjoy working the window," she said. "If I can make someone's day, that makes me feel good. I feel luck. I get up in the morning and want to go to work."

Not only does she look forward to dealing with customers, but those interactions have also helped her. "I used to be kind of shy," she said. "The postal service has brought out a better part of me."

While the Wellington resident has enjoyed her time in Hoopeston, she is looking forward to the challenges of her new position. "I think it will be fun," she said.
