Hoopeston Area to implement Internet safety program

Hoopeston Area schools are implementing a program that will keep government money coming in and improve student safety on the Internet

The district plans to install SquidGuard software, which will block inappropriate web sites, such as those containing pornography and violence, said district network administrator James Eyrich.

The free software meets guidelines established under the Child Internet Protection Act and will allow the dis-

trict to continue receiving E-money, which comes through telephone user taxes. The district could receive as much as \$20,000 in E-money, said district technology coordinator Larry Jahn.

Because of the cost of most monitoring software, some districts have opted to give up E-money but finding the free software will allow Hoopeston to meet the standards and get the funds. "We try to find every dollar we can," said Superintendent Mark Conolly.

Eyrich said the program will filter based on web addresses rather than key words, which can be misleading. For example, one of the district's files, "menu december," tripped filtering software because the last two letters of "menu" and first two letters of "December" spell "nude," he said.

A public hearing on the program will be held prior to the January board meeting.

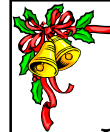

Budweiser Tournament draws 65 bowlers to Danville alley

A total of 65 bowlers were at Lincoln Lanes in Danville on Dec. 16 for the annual Budweiser Classic Bowling Tournament. The field was divided into 32 on the high side of 196 or over and 33 on the low side in the four-game qualifying format.

On the low side, Don Miller was the top qualifier with a fine 914, followed by Doug Wagoner with 904, Ron Rims, 891; Jerry Norwell, 863; and Billy Morgan Jr., 851.

In the first match, Norwell disposed of Morgan, 204-189. In a close match, Norwell then defeated Sims 212-

200, the defeated Wagoner 235-218, before meeting up with Miller and losing to the top seed, 196-182.

Nathan Nimrick led the high side, shooting 950, followed by Hall of Fame member Rick Miller with 897; Jerry Smith 885; Ed Levin 882; and Kevin West 881.

The roll-off saw Levin defeat West 200-214 and then Smith, 199-195. Miller then showed it was time to step up the game by defeating Levin 222-178. He fell short to Nimrick, losing 204-191. Nimrick then met Miller and showed his dominance with a 233-144 victory.

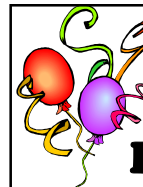
