Emergency Management Agency marks lightning week

Vermilion County Emergency Management Agency is joining with the National Weather Service to encourage lightning safety awareness.

Lightning kills more people annually than tornadoes, hurricanes or winder storms, said Rod Palming, warning coordination meteorologist with the weather service in Lincoln. Only flash flooding and river flooding have a higher death toll than lightning, Palmer said.

The week of April 28-May 4 has been set aside as national "Lightning Safety Awareness Week. "We're hoping to make people more aware of the danger lightning presents as we head into the busy spring and summer season, said county EMA training officer Jamie Davis. "We especially want to remind those engaged in outdoor activities such as hiking, camping,

water sports, ball games and golf to pay close attention when storms threaten. Lightning can reach temperatures as high as 50,000 degrees so it is very important that coaches, umpires, referees and camp counselors stop outside activity soon enough for participants to seek shelter when storms are approaching.

Emergency Management and the weather service recommend following the 30/30 rule - get inside 30 minutes ahead of an approaching storm and wait 30 minutes after thunder has stopped before going outside. If you hear thunder, you are within striking distance of lightning, Davis said.

Also, you should never use telephones during storms. According to the weather service phone use is the leading cause of indoor lightning injury in
