The Vermilion County Recycling Program will hold the collection from 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 27 at the Vermilion County fairgrounds on Route 150, Danville.

The event is co-sponsored by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Vermilion County Farm Bureau.

The Illinois EPA is discontinuing used tire collections and has announced this will be the last one offered in

Vermilion County.

This is the fourth EPA-sponsored tire collection in the county since 1995. As in the past, residents may bring as many as 1,000 tires - off rims - to the collection free of charge. Farm, truck and passenger tires will be accepted but industrial tires will not. Tire dealers are not allowed to take part in the collection.

State law requires each person to pay a \$1 disposalfee for each new tire they purchase at a retail outlet and
