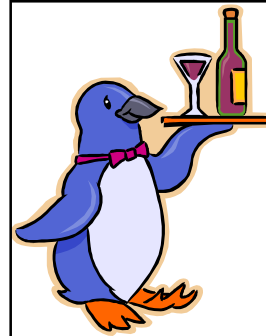
### Wrestling sign up

Any Hoopeston Area fourth through eighth grader who wishes to wrestle may sign up at 6 p.m. Monday in the high school cafeteria.

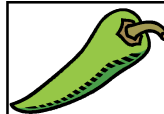
Parents should bring a copy of their student's birth certificate, completed physical and \$30 to pay for USA wrestling card which is needed to wrestle in tournaments and state.
