## Budweiser Classic invades Pla-Mor Lanes in Hoopeston

Forty-eight area bowlers converged on Hoopeston's Pla-Mor Lanes Oct. 20 for the second tournament of the year. There were 24 bowlers on the high and low sides.

On the low side, fifth seated Eric Gress bowled fourth seed Dane Nelson. Gress held on for a 191-169 victory. He then met third seed Steve Rhodes. Gress continued his hometown winning streak, winning 201-175. Curt Vise then faced Gress and squeezed Gress 204-189, pitting him against top seed William Pickett. Split city came out for Vise, and Pickett cruised to a 191-133 victory and the chance to meet the high side qualifier.

On the high side, fifth seed Brian Linzie met fourth seed Brent Myers, with Myers holding on for a 215-202 victory and the chance to meet Nathan Nimrick, the

third seed player. In a match that continued into two roll-offs after a 243 tie, Nimrick finally pulled out a victory. He then met number two Charlie Varner, who won out by the score of 243-235. Varner continued to meet top seeded and overall top bowler Brian Sparrow. In a very tight match, Sparrow held on to win, 226-215.

This set up a very tight match between Sparrow and Pickett. Sparrow used the strikes to his advantage and won the top prize, 216-206.

On Nov. 16, the tournament moves to Ridge Farm on the new lanes for a rare Saturday appearance.
