Hannah's grandparents are Phyllis and the late James (Diz) Martin of Hoopeston, and Marilyn and the late

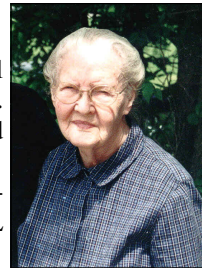
Charles Cappis of Lexington, IL.
