

Statement says former officer 'voluntarily resigned' position

A statement issued by the Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital board of directors said CEO Frank Caruso voluntarily resigned his position.

The statement was released Friday, following a board meeting Thursday night.

Board president Russ Leigh confirmed last Thursday that Caruso was no longer CEO as of Wednesday.

Officials will not comment on whether Caruso's resignation is tied to an investigation into a \$1.2 million construction and remodeling project at the hospital.

The Vermilion County Sheriff's Department has been investigating possible criminal activity regarding questionable expenses.

Earlier this month, the board halted construction pending an investigation from an independent construction specialist and engineer.

Both investigations began after the board heard rumors about the appropriateness of expenditures and quality of construction. The board then examined documentation, questioned the contractor and architectural firm representative and hired a private investigator before turning those findings over to Gary Miller, sheriff's department chief investigator. A grand jury was used to subpoena documentation.

Stratum, Inc., of St. Louis is the project contractor. Some work on the project was done by local subcontractors.

Caruso came to the hospital as chief financial officer in February 1998, under former CEO Darryl Wahler. In August 1998, Caruso was named CEO after Wahler retired.
