## Company apologizes for equipment failure at fireworks

Hoopeston's short fireworks display was the result of a problem with the electronic system, according to the fireworks company.

Jamaica Pyrotechnics, Inc. was contracted by the Hoopeston Chamber of Commerce to provide July 4 fireworks. In a press release, company officials said they experienced an equipment failure minutes into the show. As a result, several fireworks were not launched.

Once the show has been set up to fire from an electronic system, it cannot be fired manually, the release said.

Jamaica Pyrotechnics said it would refund the Chamber's money for fireworks not set off that night.

The Chamber raised \$6,000, including \$2,000 from the Hoopeston City Council. Most of the \$2,000 will be refunded to the city.

"No one was more disappointed than the owners and crew of Jamaica Pyrotechnics, as they spent over 12 hours in the hot and humid conditions preparing the display," the release said. "Jamaica Pyrotechnics' proposal for next year's display will come with a 100 percent money back guarantee."
