Director reminds it's time to update 'Vial of Life' kits

Area residents are reminded that it's time to update their "Vial of Life."
Charlene Ervin, director of Country Terrace Apartments and the Hoopeston area Vial of Life program, is reminding everyone who has a Vial of Life that it should be updated with new information, including changes in medications, doctors or phone numbers of contact people.
Vials of Life should be updated twice yearly or more often if medications change.
Vial of Life is used by emergency medical teams to get the current information on a patient when an am-

balance is called to their home. Treatment can start more rapidly if the health history of the person is known.
Vials of Life can be taken to doctor's appointments to review medications or be taken to the hospital when families are bringing someone to the emergency room. The vial is kept in the refrigerator so that its location is known to everyone.
