Hoopeston council sets TIF reimbursement guidelines

Hoopeston officials now have guidelines to distribute TIF (tax increment financing) funds.

Guidelines are divided into four projects, based on total investment and cumulative totals in real estate taxes and municipal sales tax. Levels are:

1: requires a total investment of \$250,000 or more; generates a cumulative total of \$75,000 ore more of real estate tax increment and \$40,000 or more of new sales tax over the life of the TIF district.

Incentives: rebate 50%-80% of net incremental real estate tax increases paid on an annual basis for the term of the TIF or until 75% of eligible TIF costs are repaid, whichever comes first. Thirty to 50% of new municipal sales tax increases could also be rebated for 5-12 years.

2: total investment of \$100,000 or more with \$20,000 or more in real estate tax increment and \$15,000 in new sales tax over the life of the TIF.

Incentives: rebate 50%-75% of net incremental real estate increases paid over the life of the TIF or until 75% of TIF-eligible costs are repaid, whichever comes first, and 30%-50% rebate of new municipal sales taxes for five to 12 years.

3: total investment of \$50,000 or more, generating a cumulative total of \$15,000 in real estate tax increment

Incentives are 30%-60% rebate of net incremental takes paid on an annual basis for up to eight years and 30%-50% rebate of new municipal sales tax increases

and \$5,000 or more in new municipal sales tax incre-

ment over the life of the TIF.

for up to six years. 4: total investment of \$3,000 or more, generating a cumulative total of \$500 or more in real estate increment and \$1,000 or more of new municipal sales tax incre-

ment over the life of the TIF. Incentives are 30%-50% rebate of real estate tax net incremental increase for up to four years and 30%-50% rebate of new municipal sales tax increases for up to four years.

Level 1 and 2 are anticipated to be new economic development rather than rehabilitation/renovation of existing structures. Levels 3 and 4 are anticipated to be rehabilitation.




