Rossville fire cleanup resumes, waste taken to local landfill

ROSSVILLE—Cleanup is underway again at the site of a Feb. 27 fire, weeks after the Vermilion County Health Department halted debris removal.

Doug Crawley and Scott Sprague were on site Tuesday, removing debris from the site of the downtown Rossville fire.

The waste, which had been taken to a private site near Bismarck, is now being taking to the Allied Waste facility in Hoopeston, said Mayor Terry Prillaman.

It was the waste that shut down cleanup efforts last month, after health department officials found clean waste - including concrete, bricks and rock - mixed with unclean debris, including wood, carpet and metal pipes. All waste, including that at the private site, will now be taken to the landfill, which will inrease cleanup costs. Sprague said the charge for a ton of waste is \$37. Each truck contains approximately 15-20 tons. Trucks began hauling waste Monday and were expected to maintain an almost nonstop shuttle between Rossville and Hoopeston through Thursday.

While many are happy that the remains of the fire, which burned four downtown busineeses, will be cleaned, some speculate that the cost of taking debris to the landfill will not allow owners to rebuild.

Some business owners said shortly after the fire that they were unsure if they could afford to rebuild. While insurance will pay on the buildings, that money is not expected to be enough to cover cleanup and rebuilding.
