Community Fund kicks off 2005 drive with \$40,000 goal

The 2005 United Community Fund of Grant Township's 2005 fund drive is off and running.

The group's board hosted chairmen of components of the drive at a kick-off luncheon Wednesday.

This year, the Community Fund will try to raise \$40,000 to help fund agencies serving Grant Township.

"We really do appreciate your help," said community fund chairman Lance Raver to the volunteers. "These last couple years, it's been more difficult to hit those goals (because of local economic conditions)," he said. "Your letters and phone calls are crucial to our success."

Economic conditions are affecting how much people are able to give and also how much agencies are requesting from the community fund. "Initial request amounts have gone up on the past year," Raver said.

Sixteen agencies have requested \$38,520 from the community fund. Last year, 16 agencies were given

If you're a java junkie, Hoopeston has a new business to sooth the craving.

Karen's Koffee House is open at 114 E. Main.

Proprietor Karen Plioplys "quietly" opened the business Sept. 23, offering a variety of coffee drinks, including Americano (espresso and hot water), breve (espresso mixed with half-and-half) and lattes (espresso and steamed milk). Coffees are available straight or with a shot of flavor such as chocolate, macadamia nut, cherry and berry. A different specialty flavor is offered each day.

Smoothies - cold coffee flavored beverages - are also available. Plioplys compared these to being similar to fruit-flavored milk shakes.

Since opening, Plioplys has had requests for food and is considering adding breakfasts and cold sandwiches to her fare.

She also hopes to add games, Internet and computers to draw local young people to the coffee house.

Plioplys, originally from Chicago, came to Hoopeston from Wheaton where she was employed by the school district. Her husband, Vince, continues to work in the Chicago area. The couple has three children, Brandi, 13, Devan, 10 and Felicia, seven.

The difference between the city and Hoopeston has been a bit of a culture shock for Plioplys, who, along with running the shop, is ordained in the Corellian Nativist Church. There are fewer businesses than she's used to, she is happy about her reception. "Everybody has just been wonderful and very nice," she said.

Since opening the shop, Plioplys has hired three local people to work part time. Ashley Powell

opens the business in the morning, allowing Plioplys to take her children to school, and Tony Jenkins and Alex Linares work in the evenings. She also has a silent partner who provided funding for the venture.
