The department last week began to screen people age 65 and older with chronic illnesses who are considered most at risk from the effects of influenza; they will be vaccinated by appointment only next week. Galloway said the next group to be vaccinated will be people age 19 and up with chronic illness. "The arrival of additional vaccine will eliminate the need for us to do prescreenings and make appointments," she said.

The health department received half of its original order last week. "We are extremely fortunate to now receive all of our vaccine," said Administrator Steve Laker. "The arrival of the rest of our order means we expect to be able to vaccinate those in all three high priority categories".

Earlier, in response to critically reduced supplies of flu vaccine, the health department set three high risk categories for flu shots those age 65 and older with chronic illness; those ages 19 to 64 with chronic illness; those age 65 and up.

Flu shots will be also be available at the health department, 200 S College Street in Danville from 9am to 7pm on Monday, November 22; and Trinity United Church of Christ, 311 Moses Ave., Westville from 11am to 5pm on Wednesday, November 24.

Hoopeston, Rossville Veterans Day activities announced


Hoopeston and Rossville have set Veterans Day ceremonies for Thursday.

The third round of immunizations for those age 19 and up with documented chronic illness, and those age 65 and up will be: 9 a.m.-7 p.m. Monday, November 29 at the health department in; 1-6:30 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 30 at Hoopeston United Methodist; and 1-7 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 1 at Trinity Church in Westville
