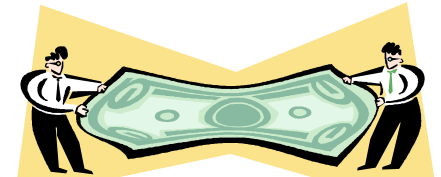

County clerk extends voter registration for April 5 election

Vermilion County Clerk Lynn Foster will offer extended voter registration hours on Saturdays Feb. 19, 26 and March 5.

New registrations, as well as address and name changes, must be completed by Tuesday, March 5 for voters to be eligible to vote in the April 5 consolidated election.

"I am frequently asked if voters are required to re-register periodically," Foster said. "In general terms, the answer is no." Voter registration in Illinois is permanent, however, voters who have moved or whose address has changed must update their registration and voters who change their names must re-register because their signatures will be different, she said.

To register to vote, applicants must be U.S. citizens and at least 18 years old by April 5, 2005. Those who wish to register who cannot do so in person may request a form to apply for voter registration by mail.

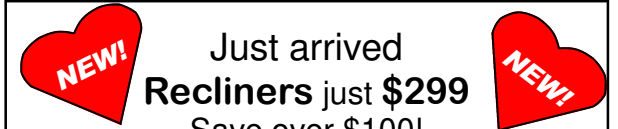
