HA students to compete, former student to direct at contest

Hoopeston Area Middle School and High School show choirs will travel to Watseka, as will a former student.

The schools' show choirs will take part in the Watseka Invitational Show Choir contest Friday and Saturday. John Shaffer, a former Hoopeston Area student, will direct the Riverton High School Show Choir as they compete in the event.

The middle school show choir, "Cornjerker Connection," is slated to compete at 6:55 p.m. Friday. They will perform "Disney Dazzle," a medley of songs from "The Little Mermaid," "Aladdin" and "Beauty and the Beast," said Hoopeston Area choral director Matthew Dix. The show is approximately 12 minutes long with fast, slow and fun numbers - "all over the Disney map, so to speak," he said.

The middle school will compete against show choirs from Paxton-Buckley-Loda, El Paso-Gridley, Mt. Zion, Hinsdale, Riverton Middle School, Danville and Wheaton.

The high school's "New Direction" will perform at 2 p.m. Saturday. Their 50s themed show will include "Rock Around the Clock." Desi Arnaz' "Cuban Pete" and "Jail House Rock." The high school show is approximately 15 minutes long.

If the high school choir is among the chosen six finalists, students will compete again beginning at 7:30 p.m.

Other high schools in the mixed competition are from Manteno, Blue Island, Palos Heights, Palatine, Pekin, Brownsburg, Ind. and Mechanicsville, Va.

Shaffer's group, "Dynamics," will compete at 9 a.m. Saturday in the varsity division against schools from Morton, Franklin Park, El Paso-Gridley and Summit.

Dix expects big things from both his groups. "Every place we've gone, we've been steadily improving both shows," he said. "I think both groups feel really good about their shows. They've gotten more comfortable with the material. I think they'll do really well."


